To Whom It Concerns,

I am writing to report what I believe to be violations of Federal election laws. I suspect this pattern of behavior is ongoing and will continue to occur without the intervention of authorities such as yourself. As you will see by the evidence presented in this document, this matter extends beyond party lines.

At a high level, the violations can be summarized as: a foreign (Canadian) company (Enbridge Inc.) has made hundreds of contributions *directly to* American political campaigns and dozens of American political party committees; likewise, hundreds of American political campaigns and dozens of American political party committees accepted contributions *from* a foreign (Canadian) company (Enbridge Inc.).

I have previously reported this matter to United States Department of Justice Foreign Agents Registration Act Unit staff, to which I received a response directing me to the Federal Election Commission as the appropriate jurisdiction for the nature of my complaint ^[C1]. Additionally, I brought this matter to the attention of Federal Election Commission Office of Inspector General, to which I received a response ^[C2] that prompted the creation of the letter you now read.

Information regarding the violations I suspect are presented — along with references to and summaries of supporting documentation — in this document with as much specificity I believe is required for authorities to decide whether to pursue this matter further. I have no personal or business connection to any of these people or organizations that I am aware of; as such, all information ultimately comes from publicly available sources that I list in this document.

This document *does not* address any potential independent expenditures related to electioneering communications made by foreign nationals or agents. 558 U.S. 310 (2010) ^[A17] acknowledges the distinction in regulatory and disclosure statutes that foreign entities are subject to on this matter primarily by omission. I believe it may be worth exploring this for potential additional violations; however, it is beyond my level of understanding at this time to make such accusations.

The information I provide in this document is true to the best of my understanding. I am not a lawyer nor have I consulted one in the drafting of this document. It is my intention that any facts, assumptions or accusations presented in this document be critically examined by professionals to determine their validity. I do not intend to falsely accuse the innocent; rather, I acknowledge my own lack of subject matter expertise in presenting what I believe to be serious matters of election integrity. My motives are based purely on a sense of patriotic duty.

Regarding procedure, I believe this document satisfies all requirements to report suspected violations of Federal Election Commission laws and regulations ^[A16]. This document is being sent by mail, but I am happy to communicate via modern methods should further communication be required and have supplied my email and phone number for that purpose. I am happy to provide any further information or clarification as requested in any format. Please contact me should you have questions or concerns.

A final comment on procedure, I am sending this letter to two separate addresses out of both confusion and caution. The website of Federal Election Commission states complaints are to be mailed to an address containing '1050 First Street, NE' as the street address ^[A15]; however, *linked to on that same page*, a PDF document, also produced by Federal Election Commission, states complaints are to be mailed to an address containing '999 E Street, N.W.' as the street address ^[A16]. I point this matter out only to explain why multiple copies were sent to two addresses.

Enbridge Allegations

Suspected Violations Summary

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BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Enbridge Inc.

Enbridge Inc. is a publicly traded oil pipeline company based in Calgary, Canada ^[A1]. According to 52 U.S.C. § 30101 ^[A2], foreign principals are prohibited from making contributions to campaigns or political party committees. The jurisdiction of incorporation qualifies Enbridge Inc. as a foreign principal under 22 U.S.C. § 611(b) ^[A3].

Enbridge (U.S.) Inc.

Enbridge (U.S.) Inc. is 100% indirectly owned by Enbridge Inc ^[A4]. Its articles of incorporation are filed in Delaware, though its ownership leads back to Canada by way of the Cayman Islands ^[A5].

Enbridge-DCP PAC

Enbridge (U.S.) Inc. Political Action Committee (Enbridge-DCP PAC) (referred to in this document as the PAC) is a political action committee registered to Enbridge (U.S.) Inc. in Texas ^[A6]. In an attempt to comply with registration requirements under 22 U.S.C. § 613(h) ^[A3], Enbridge-DCP PAC reported it acts as an agent of foreign interests in its lobbying efforts by stating, "Interests of Enbridge Inc. are those of parent company." ^[A7]

NATURE OF THE ALLEGED OFFENSE

Campaign Contributions

Under 52 U.S.C. § 30101(a)(1)(A) ^[A2], it is prohibited for a foreign national, directly or indirectly, to make a contribution or donation of money or other thing of value, or to make an express or implied promise to make a contribution or donation, in connection with a Federal, State, or local election. To my knowledge, these offenses are under the authority of Federal Election Commission Office of General Counsel.

Federal

According to lobbying disclosures by Enbridge-DCP PAC ^{[A8][A9][A10][A11]}, the PAC made seventy (70) direct contributions to fifty (50) Federal election campaigns ^[B1]. The total amount of reported contributions was **\$123,200.00** ^[B1].

State and Local

According to FEC filings ^{[A12][A13]}, the PAC made approximately two hundred and ninety nine (299) direct contributions to two hundred and thirty eight (238) state and local campaigns ^[B3]. The net amount of reported contributions was **\$339,200.00** ^[B3].

Political Party Contributions

Under 52 U.S.C. § 30101(a)(1)(B) ^[A2], it is prohibited for a foreign national, directly or indirectly, to make a contribution or donation to a committee of a political party. To my knowledge, these offenses are under the authority of Federal Election Commission Office of General Counsel.

Federal

According to lobbying disclosures by Enbridge-DCP PAC ^{[A8][A9][A10][A11]}, the PAC made two (2) direct contributions to two (2) Federal political party committees ^[B1]. The total amount of reported contributions was **\$20,000.00** ^[B1].

State and Local

According to FEC filings ^{[A12][A13]}, the PAC made approximately twenty two (22) direct contributions to fifteen (15) state and local political party committees ^[B3]. The net amount of reported contributions was **\$60,200.00** ^[B3].

Acceptance of Prohibited Contributions

Under 52 U.S.C. § 30101(a)(2) ^[A2], it is unlawful for a person to solicit, accept, or receive a contribution or donation described in the preceding alleged offenses. As such, for each contribution described above (with possible exceptions), there was at least one person or committee to accept, and possibly solicit, the money in question. To avoid redundancy, I will simply summarize that fifty two (52) Federal campaign or political party committees ^[B4] are implicated in these allegations along with two hundred and fifty three (253) state and local campaign or political party committees. To my knowledge, these offenses are under the authority of Federal Election Commission Office of General Counsel.

Prohibited Foreign Trade Practices

The actions described above as Campaign Contributions and Political Party Contributions may also fall under 15 U.S.C. § 78dd-1(a)(1) ^[A14] and 15 U.S.C. § 78dd-1(a)(1) ^[A14] respectively. Enbridge Inc. is an issuer under the securities exchange jurisdiction of the United States, though not American with regard to jurisdiction of incorporation, thereby making American officials and political parties “foreign” to Enbridge Inc. To my knowledge, these offenses are **not** under the authority of Federal Election Commission Office of General Counsel.

However, all OIG complaints and investigative matters are confidential under the Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended, and other laws and regulations. Confidentiality is critical for the OIG to be able to effectively and independently conduct administrative and criminal investigations. Therefore, our office does not provide notice of the opening or closing of complaint-based inquiries or investigations, or information regarding the progress, developments, decisions, results or outcomes of complaint-based inquiries or investigations.

There are two instances in which you might hear back from the OIG. The first of these is if a complaint is misfiled with our office when it should have been filed with another FEC office or another agency, such as the Department of Justice or Election Assistance Commission. Second, in some instances, we may need to contact you for additional information to be able to proceed with an inquiry.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Complaints involving an alleged violation of federal election or campaign finance law fall under the jurisdiction of the FEC Office of General Counsel (OGC), not the Office of Inspector General. The OIG does not forward or transfer election and campaign finance law complaints to the OGC due to statutory requirements set forth in the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, specifically 2 U.S.C. 437g(a)(1). 
