Please consider this letter the official response for Volunteers for Shimkus related to MUR 7594.

Volunteers for Shimkus accepted two contributions from Enbridge (U.s.) Inc. PAC (Enbridge-dcp Pac) during the 2018 election cycle. One contribution in the amount of \$2500 designated for the Primary 2018 election and one contribution in the amount of \$2500 designated for the General 2018 election. Both these contributions were reported on our regular reports to the Federal Election Commission "FEC".

At the time of the contribution "Enbridge" was registered as a Multi-Candidate Federal PAC with the FEC. FEC ID number C00429662. We had and still have no knowledge of any of the alleged violations involving Enbridge as outlined by the complainant in MUR 7594.
