On April 18, 2019, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified your clients, Vicente Gonzalez for Congress and Janica Kyriacopoulos as treasurer, Heidi for Senate and Jessica Haak as treasurer, Kaptur for Congress and Thomas Jaffee as treasurer, The Bill Keating Committee and David Doucette as treasurer, Citizens to Elect Rick Larsen and Brooke Davis as treasurer, Friends of Chris Murphy and Kathy Altobello as treasurer, Richard E. Neal for Congress Committee and Michael Hall, Pallone for Congress and Warren Goode as treasurer, Peterson for Congress and Elliott Peterson as treasurer, Filemon Vela for Congress and Mary Jo Vela, and Gene Green Congressional Campaign and Helen Green as treasurer, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

On July 2, 2020, based upon the information contained in the complaint and information provided by respondents, the Commission found no reason to believe that your clients violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(2). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the basis for the Commission's decision is enclosed.
