1. Decided by a vote of 4-0 to:
  - a. Dismiss the allegation that Enbridge, Inc. violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(1) and send a letter of caution.
  - b. Dismiss the allegation that Enbridge (U.S.) Inc., Enbridge (U.S.) Inc. Political Action Committee and K. Ritu Talwar in her official capacity as treasurer, and Enbridge Energy Company, Inc. violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(1).
  - c. Find no reason to believe that the Federal and State Committee Respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(2).

3. Failed by a vote of 2-2 to:

Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated December 4, 2019, subject to the Factual and Legal Analysis circulated by Commissioner Trainor's Office on July 1, 2020.

Commissioners Hunter and Trainor voted affirmatively for the motion. Commissioners

Walther and Weintraub dissented.

4. Decided by a vote of 4-0 to:

- a. Approve the appropriate letters.
- b. Close the file.
