SUBJECT: MUR 7597 (formerly RR 17L-36) (Texas Democratic Party)  
Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation and Case Closing

On April 25, 2019, the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") found reason to believe that the Texas Democratic Party and Gilberto Hinojosa in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and (b) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a) and (b).<sup>1</sup> On May 22, 2019, the Commission approved a Conciliation Agreement circulated by this Office<sup>2</sup>
